



Chief Electrician

The role of the Chief Electrician is to manage all electrical equipment in a safe and efficient manner

QUALIFICATIONS

- Valid certificate of competence, including HV certificate, in accordance with STCW A-III / 1 and A-III / 2
- Documented minimum 24 months practical experience as electrician on mobile units.
- Completed training in the company's governing documentation.
- In compliance to the flag State competence requirements and documentation
- Fluent written/oral English language.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Operations

- The primary function of the Chief Electrician is to ensure that all electrical machinery, plant and equipment are operated and maintained to the highest degree of safety and performance.
- The Chief Electrician's responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the execution of the planned maintenance and of repairs and advising the Chief Engineer on the ordering of spares and consumables.
- This person is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the High Voltage system and of the vessel's internal communication systems.
- The Chief Electrician is responsible for all the work on any electrical part of the vessel being carried out in a safe and efficient manner that only approved electrical equipment is taken on the vessel and used there and that relevant electrical procedures, including the Permit to Work System, are followed.
- The Chief Electrician's responsibilities also include reporting as required by OOS International's Integrated Management System. They will have responsibility for Budgetary Control of the Electrical Department under the direction of the Chief Engineer.
